Performance Competition – General Information

To recognise members' efforts in promoting the breed by entering competitions, the Council will run the performance competition for ridden and in hand Irish horses.

Publicity will be given in our newsletter and on Facebook.



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- **Please note** the revamped conditions, points and prizes for this year.
- The horse (filly, colt, mare. Stallion or gelding) must be registered with IDHS (NZ).
- The owner/competitor must be a financial member of the IDHS (NZ).
- The competition shall run from the **1 August to the 31 July** the following year (placings can only be used in one performance competition entry).
- All "Ridden Competition" horses must only gain points from competitions under saddle.
- Competition scores can be backdated for late entries.
- Horses sold during the year may have their scores transferred to the new owner on application of the Secretary and provided the new owner is, or becomes a member of the IDHS (NZ).
- Entries must be made on the official score sheet and be accompanied by the \$15 entry fee.
- **Score sheets must be returned to the performance co-ordinator no later than the 31 August each year. Results will be announced by 30 September.**
- The Council reserves the right to delete any competition which it considers ineligible for this competition and to check results with any shows/events it considers necessary.
- Trophies must be returned by the 31 July.
- **AN HONESTY SYSTEM WILL OPERATE.**

PRIZES – 2019/2020 Competition (*Points collected from 1 Aug 2019-31 July 2020*)

In-hand Competition:

Winner to receive the Crystal Horse Head Trophy, Most Points Sash, certificate

The breeder of the winning horse will be presented with a society silver medal.

2nd will receive a certificate, Runner Up Sash,

3rd will receive a certificate,

Placegetters 4th - 6th will receive certificates

Ridden Competition:

Winner to receive the Galway Crystal Clock trophy donated by Anne and Thady Ryan, Most Points Sash, certificate

The breeder of the winning horse will be presented with a society silver medal.

2nd will receive a certificate, Runner Up Sash,

3rd to 6th will receive a certificate,

In addition the following will be awarded:

- The Old Cup Trophy and sash for the horse gaining the most points in Dressage
- Sash for the horse gaining the most points in Eventing
- Sash for the horse gaining the most points in Show Jumping
- Sash for the horse gaining the most points in Working Hunter and RTR classes
- Sash and Shamrock Trophy kindly donated by Coleraine Horses for the horse gaining the most points in Show Hunter
- Sash and Trophy kindly donated by the Trevalda Irish Sporthorse Stud for the horse gaining the most points in Showing classes
- Sash for the mare gaining the most points
- Rosette for the Most Versatile Horse (if there is a tie for the bonus points awarded for versatility, then the Rosette will be awarded to the horse that has gained the most points overall)
- Rosette for the Most Unusual Event points gained in
- Rosette for the Horse with more than 50% ID blood with the Most Points



IN HAND COMPETITION

(for horses 3 years and under) Eligible Classes



Any in hand class will be eligible, eg those at A&P Shows, Breed shows, Pony Club competitions. (Turnout and handler classes are excluded)

Any Other Equestrian Activity (validity and points to be decided by Council)

Bonus Points –

1. Versatility – excelling in two or more fields above throughout year, each event to be counted once for the year – 10 points (for each type)
2. Supreme Champion 10 pts Champion 6 pts Reserve Champion 4 pts
3. Competing for National or Regional Team 20 points
4. Any points scored at Horse of the Year, a Royal Show or a National event will be doubled.
